COMMUNITY CAPITALS FRAMEWORK

BUILT	Infrastructure that supports the community	SOCIAL	Connections or bonds between individuals within a community
POLITICAL	Ability to influence local policy, standards, and law	CULTURAL	Collaboration across and within cultures; it influences what voices are the loudest and most heard
NATURAL	Natural amenities and the environment, wildlife and natural beauty	HUMAN	Skills and abilities of residents and the capacity to address outside resources
FINANCIAL	Resources required to start businesses, invest in community spaces, support entrepreneurship and build wealth

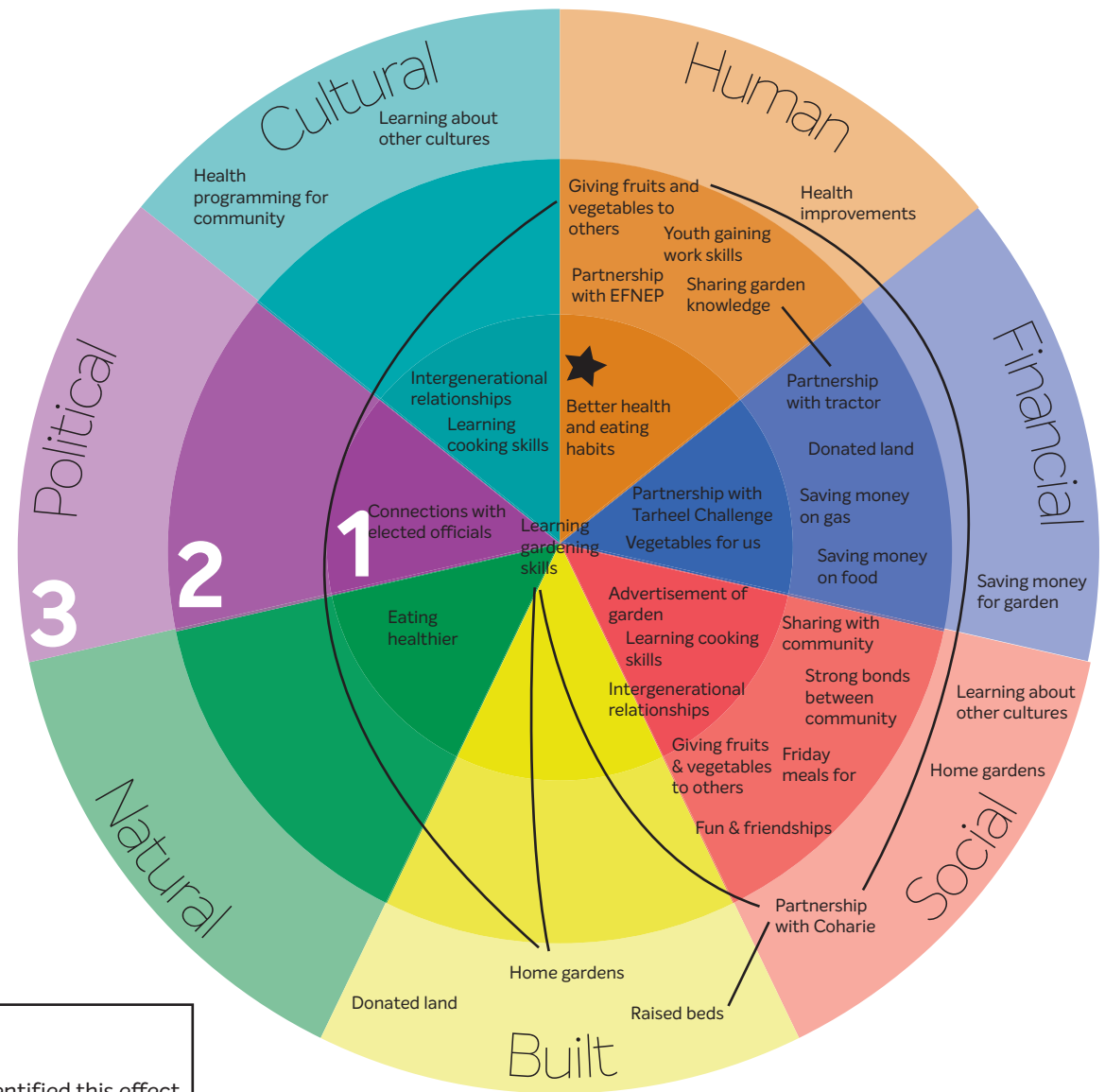
